

2010 Karns Community Fair ~ Guidelines and Application for Booth Space (for Businesses, Politicians and Non-Profits)

The 56th annual Karns Community Fair will be held at Karns High School on July 24th from 10:00 a.m. -3:00pm (Booths need to be set up by 9:00am). The Karns Business Association invites businesses and politicians to operate booths at the Fair. There is a \$65 fee per booth for businesses and Politicians. (\$25 for Non-Profits).

Since the fair is a community oriented event, we have guidelines for those who choose to participate:

1. Booth activities should be appropriate to the family-oriented nature of the fair.
2. Businesses are not permitted to sell food or drinks with the exception of those selling food that will be consumed at a later time (such as Homemade Gourmet).
3. Any plans to sell or give away anything (especially food or drinks) at the Fair must be approved by the Fair Board.
4. One table and two chairs are provided for each booth.
5. More than one adjoining booth space may be purchased.
